Norman C. Moore, age 78, born in Brownsville, Texas, passed away on March 30th from complications of ALS. He lived for the past ten years at the Veterans' residential center in Menlo Park, CA. He attended UC Berkeley and San Jose State University and graduated with degrees in physics, computer science and psychology and an advanced degree in math. He was an Army veteran during the Vietnam War era and served from 1963 to 1965. He was a loyal member of the United Methodist Church in Burlingame since 1959 and served as an usher there for many years. Norman was an animal lover and adored the family cat, a beautiful and intelligent Himalayan cat named Cokie. As the family well knows he loved grape juice, cheeseburgers and sweets of all kinds.
