Cindy was born on April 23, 1966 in Juneau, Alaska, had two brothers: Lee Wilson (Juneau), Jim Wilson (South Dakota) and two sisters: Valerie Wilson (Juneau) and Robin Wilson (Sandra Amanda Dhaenens). After completing high-school Cindy went to school at Long Beach City College, where she met long time boyfriend and graduated with a BA in 1993.
