Mr. Suey Ho Leong passed away peacefully on August 20th, 2014 at his home in San Francisco. His wish was to reside in his home until his passing. He was 78 years old. He is survived by his beloved wife Eva, his daughter Doris and her husband Frank; his son David and his wife Sophie; his daughter Diane and her husband Him; his daughter Daisy and her husband Waiman, his nine grandchildren; and elder brothers, Suey Ting and James.
