Robert E. Wells Jr., aged 88, passed away on Thursday, January 10, 2013 in San Mateo after a long illness. Inez L. Wells, aged 88, passed away on Saturday, January 12, 2013 due to natural causes. Robert was born in Florida and Inez in Georgia. They met and married after attending Palm Beach High School together. They were each other's best friend and soul mate for 68 years. Robert and Inez were residents of San Mateo for 59 years. Robert was a WWII Veteran, President and owner of the Clearview Corporation. He was an avid tennis player and enjoyed golf. After a brief time as a dental assistant, Inez devoted her life to care for her husband and family. She enjoyed travel, skiing and was always an expert on the contents of the "Chronicle."
