Celebrating the life of Rong-Lih Wang Rong-Lih Wang was born on the 14th of August in 1943 in Qung-Lai, Sze Chuan in China to loving parents, Hui-Ching Lee and Hsin-Kao Wang. She was the oldest of 6 children; with 2 younger brothers and 3 younger sisters. She lived in Qung-Lai, Sze Chuan until the age of 4, and moved to Taiwan. She studied at National Taiwan University and earned a Bachelor's of Science Degree in the study of Literature. She had such a linguistic talent, fluent in many languages, such as Sze Chuan, Shanghainese, Mandarin, Fujian, Cantonese, Taiwanese and English. She also took part in casually learning Spanish and Japanese. In 1967, Rong-Lih married the love of her life, George Chou-Chong Chen. Rong-Lih and her newlywed husband relocated moved to Hong Kong and Rong-Lih began working as a scripture reader at Far East Broadcasting – Hong Kong. After three years, Rong-Lih and George started their family. They had three children, David, Yvonne and May. When the children were a bit older, Rong-Lih started working again. For 10 years, she worked as a secretary at Overseas Trust Bank. During the last couple of years at Overseas Trust Bank, she started her own business of Import and Export Trading. In 1989, Rong-Lih and her family moved to the United States of America. They mostly lived in the bay area; San Mateo, Milpitas and Hillsborough.
