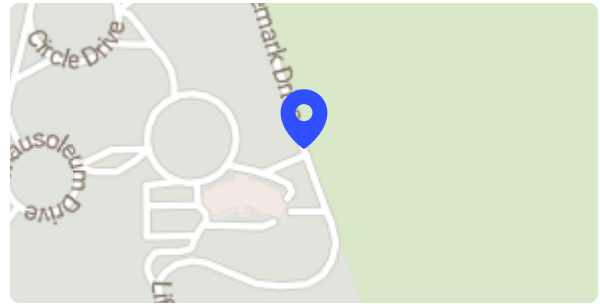

She was very involved in many areas from beekeeping to education to much world travel and primarily Christian activities and missions.






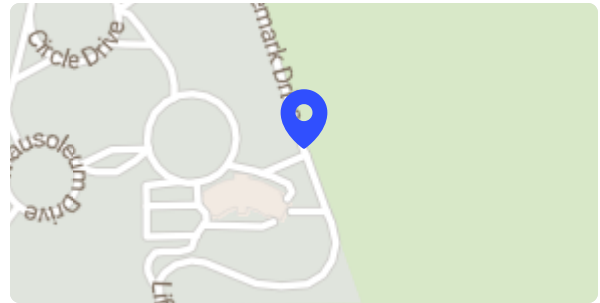

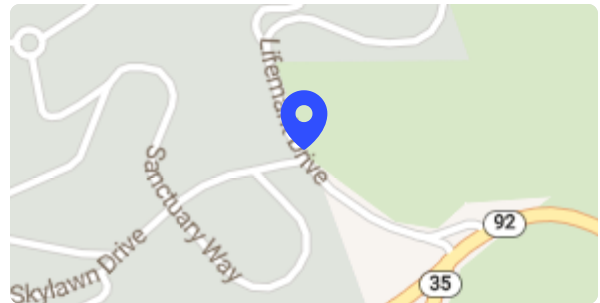

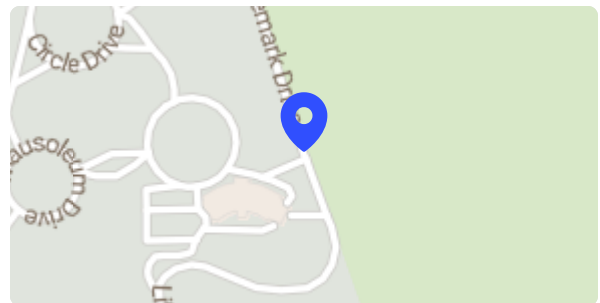
