Rest in Paradise Nay, we love you!



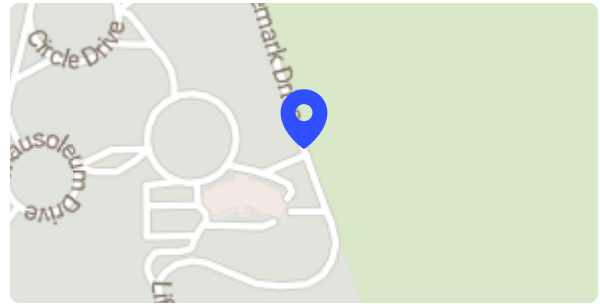
