It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Mrs. Cecil Mae Mesick, 83 of San Bruno, CA on, September 12, 2022.

Cecil Mae Mesick (Thomas) was born July 22, 1939 in Helena, Phillips County, Arkansas from the union of mother Queen Isabella Wilson and father Cecil Hanibel Thomas.

She grew up in Helena, AR until the approximate age of 12 when her father moved the family to Pittsburgh, PA in 1951.
