Jean Lo Chan January 8, 1930 – December 20, 2023

Jean was born January 8, 1930 in Manila, Philippines to Lo Ching and Mak Lei Qun. She completed her high school graduation and worked in her family grocery business in the Philippines where she met her husband Fausto Luis Chan and eventually married on February 23, 1957.

Upon finally settling in San Francisco after Luis' retirement in 1996, she was the ultimate grandmother and a prominent figure in the upbringing of all her 9 grandchildren. Unfortunately in her later years, she was not able to be as prominent a figure with her first great grandchild, Liam...she would have loved to be there for him.

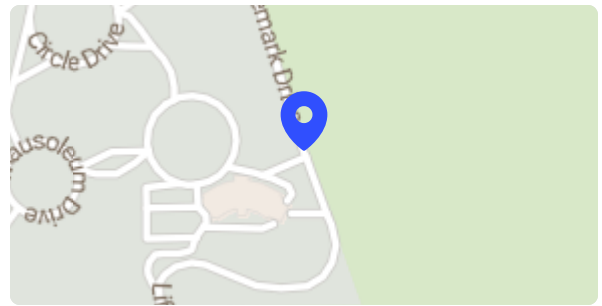
