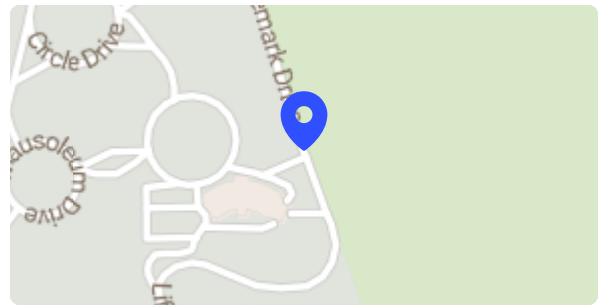
grandchild that was born was given a blanket crocheted by her own hands. This was a testament of how much she cared and loved each of them.
