Catalina Aragon Huerta November 26, 1932 - October 10, 2024

Born in Uruapan, Michoacán, Mexico, and later making her home in San Francisco, California, Catalina (Kati) Huerta was the pure definition of a matriarch. Her legacy is woven into the fabric of her family's lives and the community she tirelessly served.

Kati's favorite moments at Mission Dolores included making floral arrangements for the altar, monitoring the Eucharist Ministers, working at the gift shop at the old Mission, and her memorable honor of receiving Communion from Pope John Paul I in 1987 at Candlestick Park.

Kati had a passion for arts and crafts, creating elaborate Nativity scenes during Christmas, and collecting stamps. She had a playful spirit, love for her pets (Deliah, Pedro, and Luna) and was a devoted fan of the San Francisco Giants.
