Marilyn Pearson, a resident of Daly City for 71 years, passed away on Sunday, May 2nd, 2021, after a long battle with cancer. She was 84 years old.

Marilyn was born on sept 12, 1936 in San Francisco, the daughter of Virginia and Clem Tice, a decorated Air Force colonel, who moved throughout the United States until settling in Daly City in 1950.
